**4.1. Description of first aid measures**

**In the event of swallowing :**

Seek medical attention, showing the label.

Rinse mouth and drink plenty. If symptoms persist, consult a doctor.

Inhalation: cough, sneezing

In case of inhalation of decomposition products in a fire, symptoms may be delayed. The exposed person may need to remain under medical supervision for 48 hours.

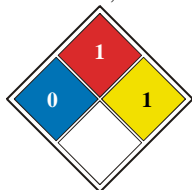
